

George Georgantas is Second Vice-President of the Hellenic Parliament since July 2023.

He has served as Minister of Rural Development and Food from February 2022 to May 2023, as well as Deputy Minister of Digital Governance, responsible for Simplification of Procedures, from July 2019 to February 2021. In November 2014, by decision of the Prime Minister, Mr. Antonis Samaras, he was appointed Deputy Minister of Education, Religious Affairs and Lifelong Learning, while from February 2016 to July 2019 he was Head of the Sector of Administrative Reconstruction of New Democracy, following a decision of the President, Mr. Kyriakos Mitsotakis.

He was born in 1967 in Agia Paraskevi, Kilkis, where he has been elected Member of Parliament, in all elections since May 2012. He studied at the Law School of the Democritus University of Thrace and since 1992 he has been practicing law.

He has an active parliamentary presence, having participated in various committees of the Parliament, such as the Standing Committee on Public Administration, Public Order and Justice, while he has played a key role, as a member of the Committee of Inquiry for the investigation of scandals in the field of Health during the years 1997-2014 and of the Special Parliamentary Committee for the conduct of a preliminary examination, in accordance with the decision of the Plenary of the Parliament taken during the session of February 21, 2018, on the NOVARTIS case.

He is married to Efthymia Koliouka and they have two children.
